2010 Boy Scout Camp and Shoot Week-E

On April 23-25, 2010 Tusco Rifle club will be hosting the Netawotwes district of the Buckeye Council for a weekend of camping and shooting for the shotgun and rifle merit badge.

Friday April 23, beginning at 5pm Tusco Rifle club will welcome all troops from the area for camp setup and orientation and an evening of Scout fellowship.

Saturday April 24, beginning at 8:30 am with a flag raising service and safety meeting. All ranges will open at 9:00 am with BSA and or NRA approved certified range instructors as well as BSA and or NRA approved range safety officers. The requirements for the shooting portion of the merit badge are as follows. Shotgun req. 20 twenty five bird rounds of trap with a score of 24 out of 50. Scouts are allowed a break between rounds. For the rifle portion (22lr only) Scouts must shoot 5- five round groups that can be covered with a quarter at 50ft. The class room portion of the merit badge will be up to the individual troops. Ranges should be closed for lunch and be closing down by 5 pm, at the discretion of the range officers.

With proper notification and the support of Tusco Rifle club and Buckeye Council, NETA district the attendance for this weekend could easily top 200 area youth and make a excellent end to the summer vacation season!
