

# RANGE RULES

(sept. 2009)

## RIMFIRE RANGE

### Permissible firearms:

1. Rim-fire rifles and pistols only

### Approved targets

1. Paper targets on wood, plastic or metal frame target stands at least 12 inches above ground level.
2. Manufactured metal reactionary type swinging and/or knock-down targets.

No other targets are permissible

All brass to be cleaned up and all target debris to be carried away.

## 100 yard range

### Permissible firearms

1. All pistol, rifle, slug guns and sub-machine guns.  
.50 cal. BMG firing prohibited.

### Approved targets

1. Paper targets on wood, plastic or metal frame target stands at least 12 inches above ground level.
2. Manufactured metal reactionary type swinging and/or knock-down targets.

No other targets are permissible.

All brass to be cleaned up and all target debris to be carried away.

## 50 yard range

### Permissible firearms

1. Pistols, rifles, sub-machine guns and shotguns.

### Approved targets

1. Paper targets on wood, plastic or metal frame target stands at least 12 inches above ground level.
2. Manufactured metal reactionary type swinging and/or knock-down targets.
3. Clay targets on the impact berm
4. Cans, plastic bottles and jugs (no glass) and wooden bowling pins may be used as targets on this range if elevated at least 12 inches above ground level.

No other targets are permissible.

All brass to be cleaned up and all target debris to be carried away.

## TRAP RANGE

### Permissible firearms

1. Shotguns only – maximum #4 shot allowed.

### Approved targets

1. Clay birds only.
2. Pattern board/paper at designated area.

# INDOOR RANGE

## Permissible firearms

1. .22 rim-fire rifles and pistols of the approved calibers posted.

## Approved targets

- 1, Paper targets only.  
All brass to be cleaned up and targets to be disposed of.

# MAIN RANGE

## PERMISSIBLE FIREARMS

1. Rim-fire and center-fire rifles and pistols only  
No 50 cal. BMG  
and  
No full auto permitted.

## Approved targets

1. Paper targets only on existing target frames.
2. Paper targets on wood, plastic or metal frame target stands at least 12 inches above ground level is permissible at 50 & 100 yards with acceptable backstop sufficient to prevent damage to other equipment or structures.
3. firing on metal sideline sighter targets permitted with pistol and lead rifle bullets only.  
All brass to be cleaned up and targets to be disposed of.

## 600 YARD MATTHEWS RANGE

### Permissible firearms

1. Center-fire rifle and rifle caliber pistols only.
2. 50 cal. BMG permissible with prior orientation  
No full auto permitted

### Approved targets

1. Paper targets only on wood or metal frame target stands at least 12 inches above ground level or on target stands provided by the club.
2. Manufactured metal reactionary type swinging and/or knock-down targets.

No other targets permitted

Minimum firing distance 200 yards.

All brass to be cleaned up and disposable targets to be removed.

## UTILITY RANGE

### Permissible firearms

1. All rifle, pistol, slug guns, sub-machine guns  
full auto belt fed machine guns & 50 cal. BMG.

### Approved targets

1. paper targets on frames provided by the club or on wood, plastic or metal frame target stands.
2. Cans, plastic jugs and bottles (no glass) and wooden bowling pins permitted on this range
3. Manufactured metal reactionary type swinging and/or knock-down targets allowed..

No other target material is permitted

All firing is to be confined to the target corridor area.

All brass is to be cleaned up and all target debris to be carried away
